

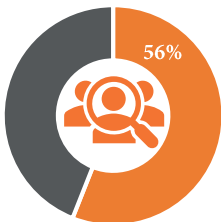

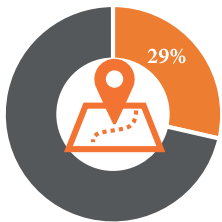
## SECTOR PROFILE AND SERVICE DELIVERY (1/2)

### Location

A total of 43 agencies responded to the sector survey. These agencies provide services in 17 municipalities, and itinerant or satellite services in 35 municipalities in the province of Alberta.



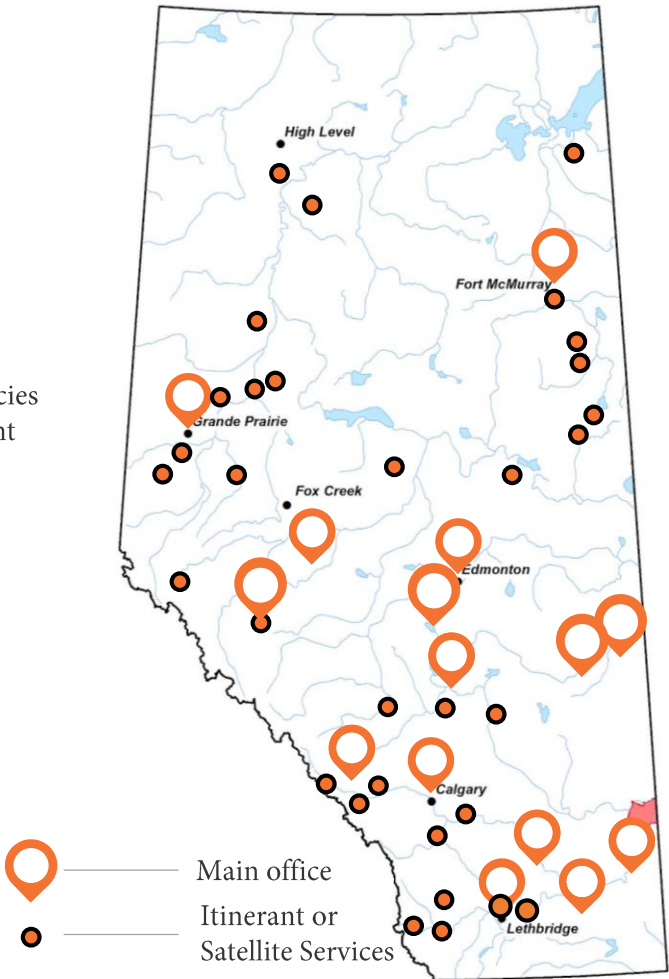
56% of agencies have a mandate to primarily serve newcomers



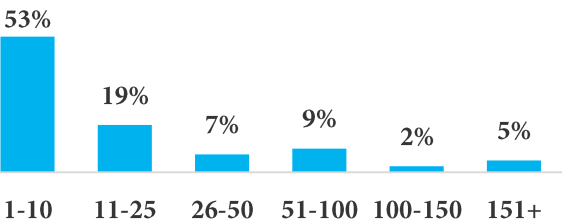
29% of agencies offer itinerant services

### Partnerships

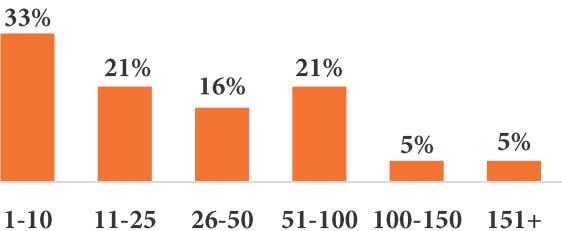
The majority of agencies indicated having partnerships with organizations inside and outside the traditional settlement and integration sector. The most popular partnerships were with other AAISA members; public libraries and municipalities; and school boards and other educational institutions, with the most common type of partnership being around language assessment and provision.



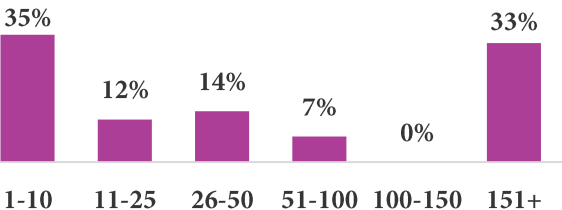

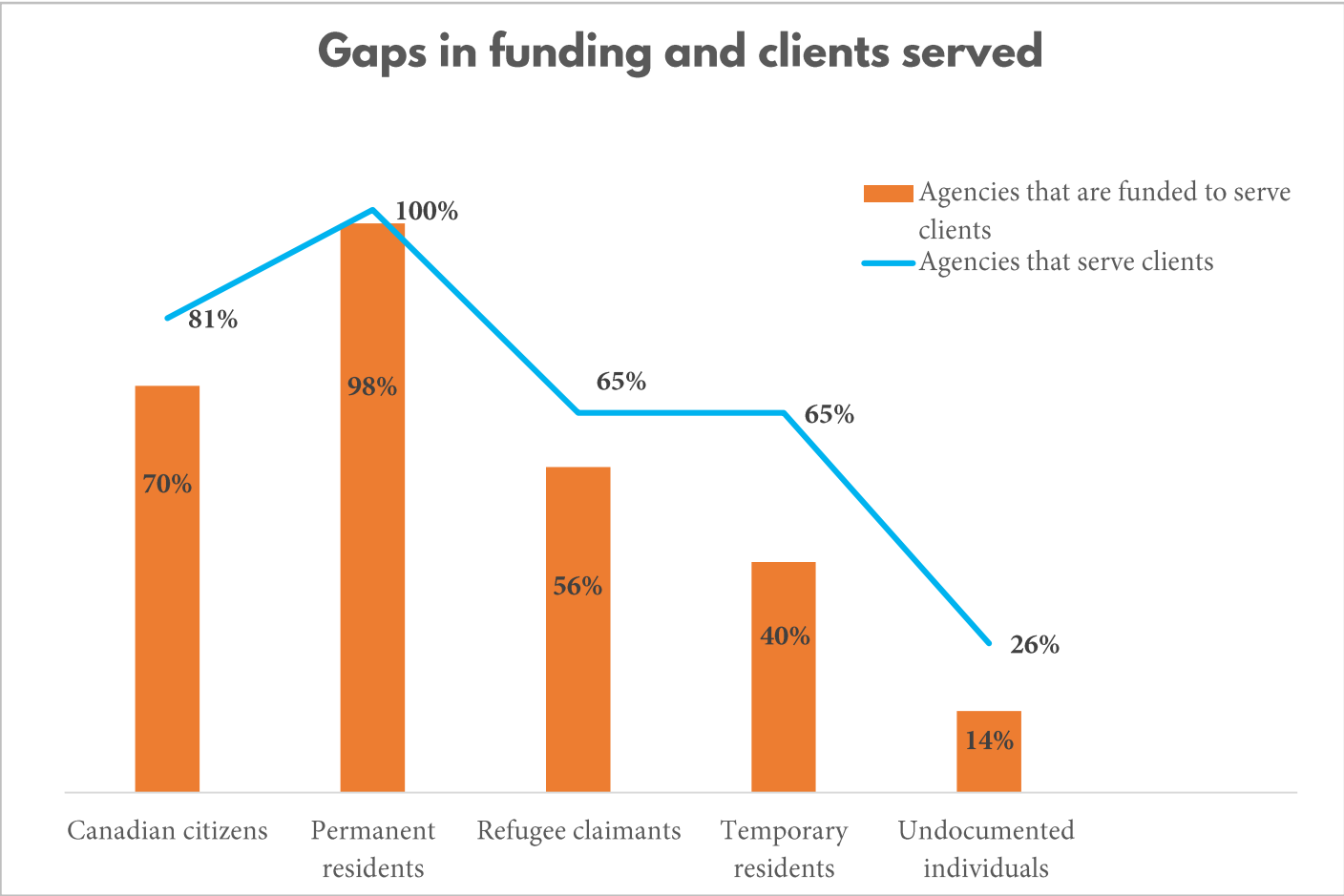

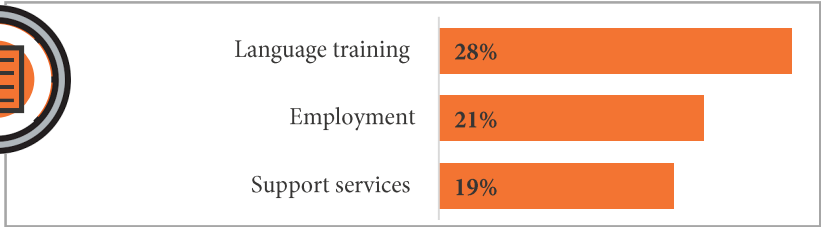

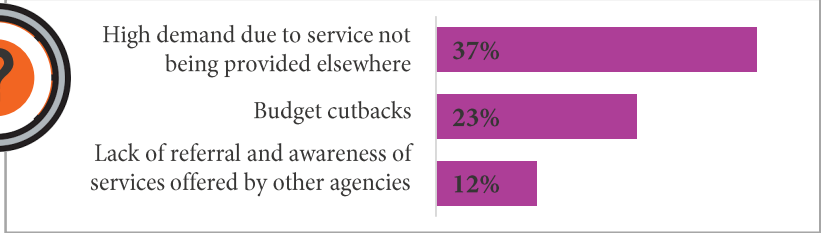
### Services with limited availability

### Top 3 reasons for services having waitlists

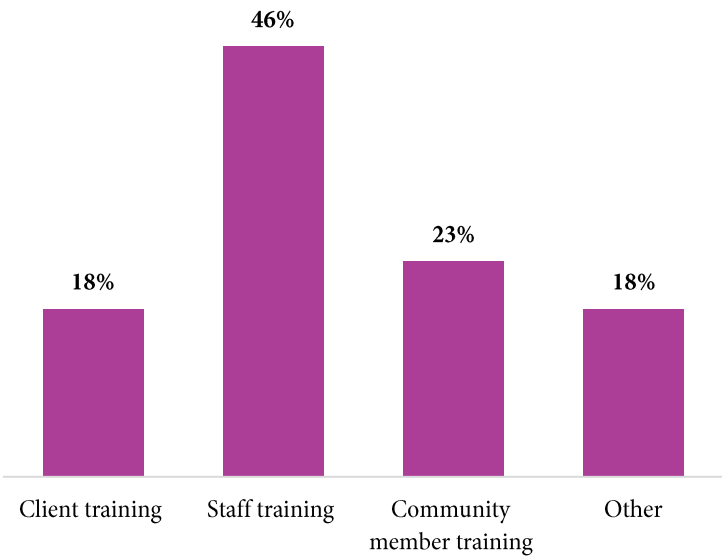

Types of in-house training provided by agencies in the sector



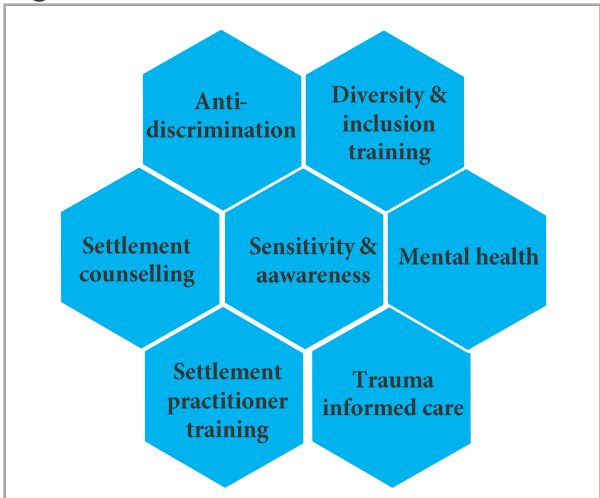

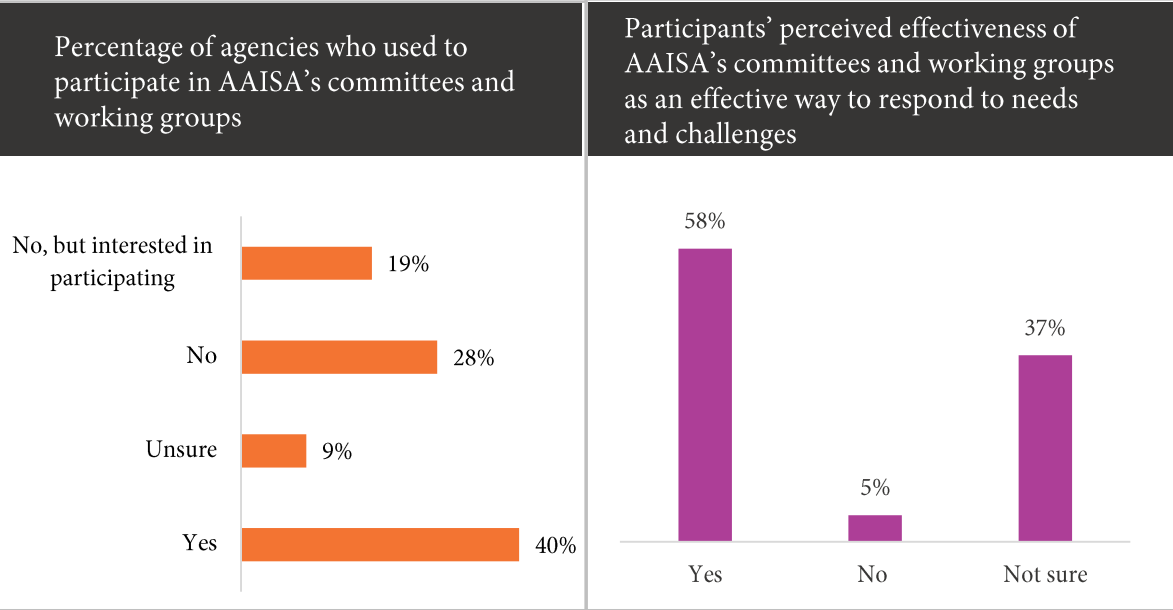
