



Disaster Preparedness LEGO® Activity

CHILDREN'S ACTIVITY - LEARN AND PLAY



This children's activity fosters participation and discussion around disaster preparedness through learning and playing. This hour-long activity encourages children to join in age-appropriate conversation about disaster, risk and climate change. All children and youth are welcome!

This activity is based on LEGO® SERIOUS PLAY, a participatory methodology enabling constructive reflection and dialogue. With the use of LEGO, children can create models that express their thoughts and reflections around climate change and disaster preparedness. This activity has four key learning moments:

1. **Invite** - Ask children to build a scenario around their disaster knowledge.
2. **Build** - Children build a LEGO model representing their ideas.
3. **Share** - Show it off! Share the story and meaning behind their build.
4. **Think** - Questions and reflections.
