Provide accurate, up-to-date information on life and employment;



Equipping immigrants with the skills and knowledge needed to enter Canada's labour market;



Facilitate community and professional connections before arrival.

Self-Directed e-Learning: PfC's new immersive virtual service allows you to explore various topics related to living and working in Canada at your own pace.




